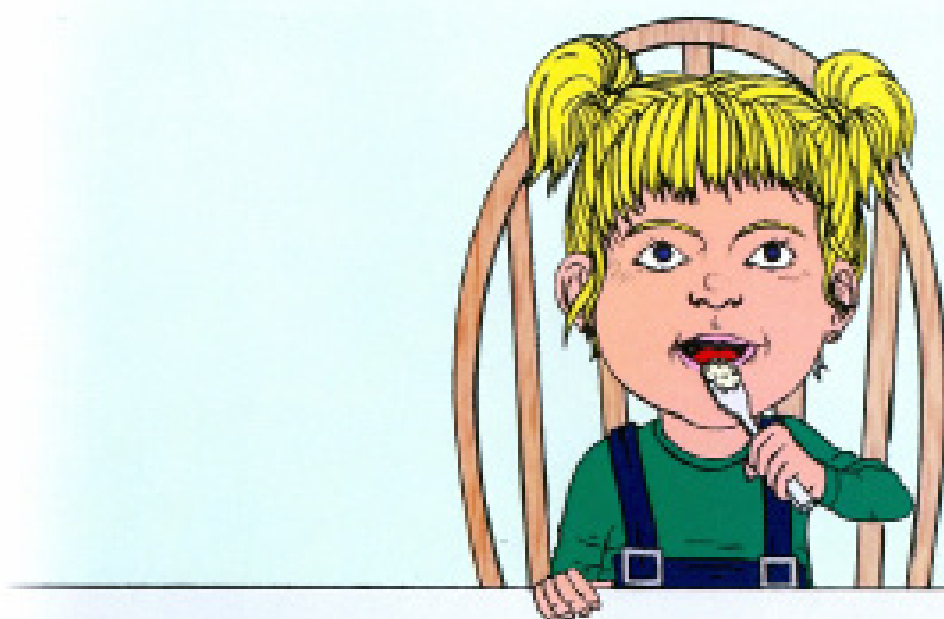
Brittany was 4 years old and a happy young girl.  
She had long golden hair and blue eyes.



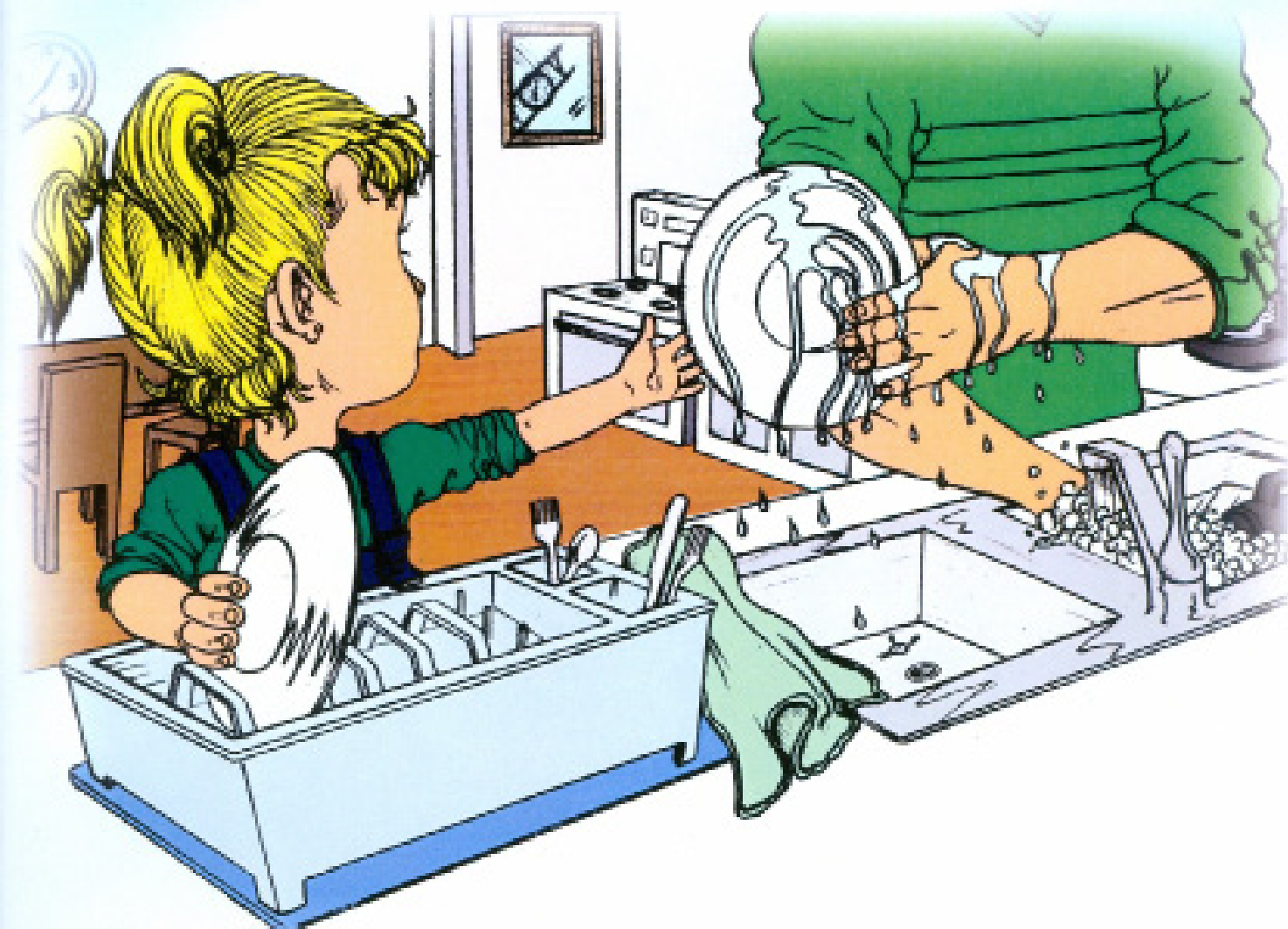
She had lots of fun at school playing with her friends, talking to the teachers, reading, printing and drawing pictures. Her favourite type of sandwich was peanut butter and jam.

When it was time to go to bed, Brittany would wash up, brush her teeth and comb her hair. She liked to wear her favorite night gown to bed. It was covered in little ponies.

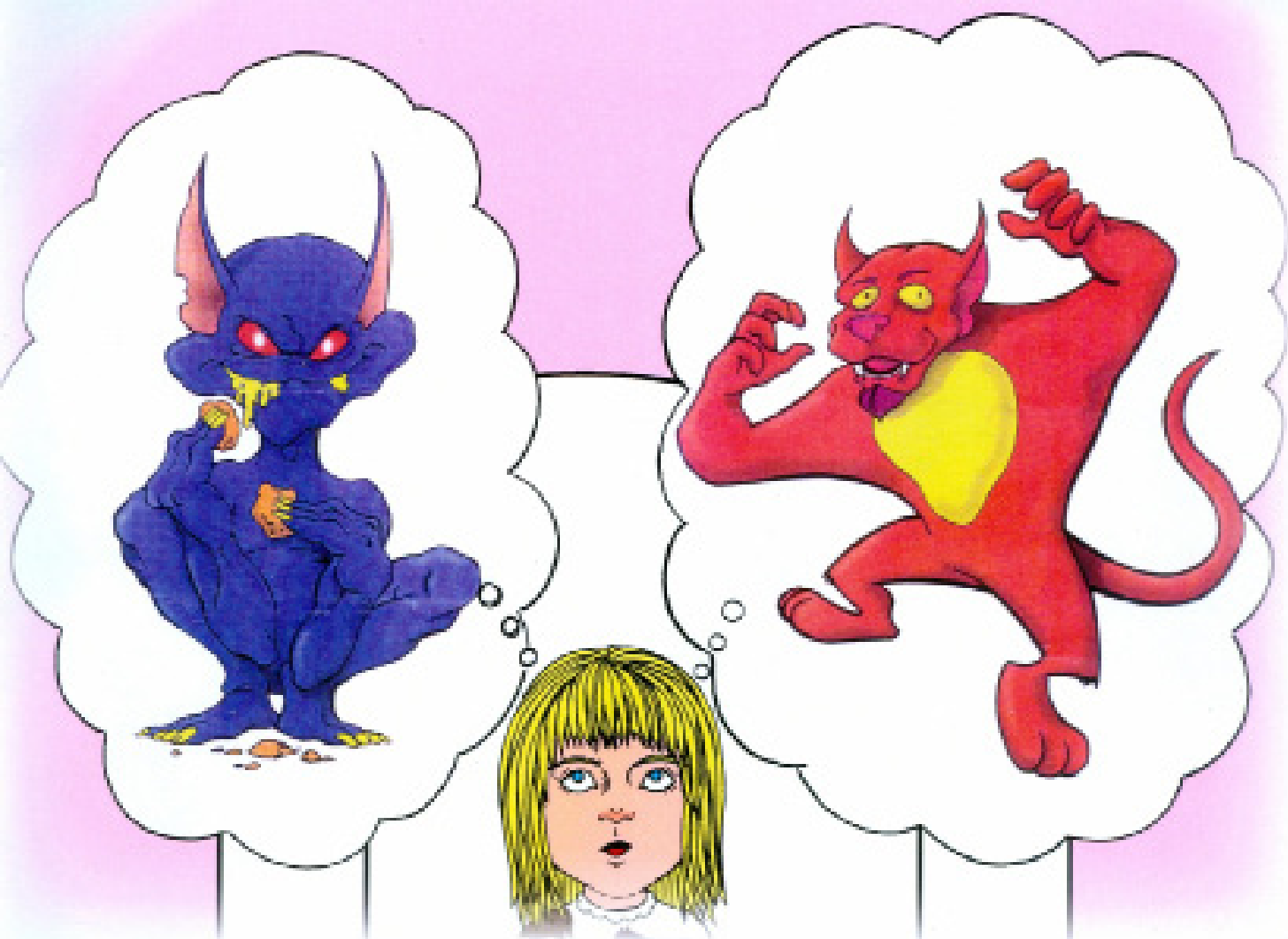


Brittany had a nice big room, with a nice big bed full of stuffed animals. She felt safe in her bed, with the lights on.
